Salford Homesafe Model - Angie Allan, Head of Intermediate care and Community Nursing for SRFT and Donna Sheeran, Principle Manager for Independent Living services, Salford City Council gave a presentation on the Salford Homesafe. Salford Homesafe is a 6 week free service although there is flexibility to extend it up to 8 , after which the patient would have the option to continue support under care on call at the patients costs.

It is hoped that the service would be live by April 2016.

3. NHS Salford CCG - Update

Francine Thorpe (FT) attended the meeting and gave the following update:

Clinical Standards board

Terms of Reference had been agreed and the first meeting was planned for 12th Nov. The first two of 12 issues that had been identified would be discussed in this meeting. They were consultant to consultant outpatient referral policy and responsibility for follow up when a clinician had ordered tests.

(FT) said that there would be representation from each of the Neighbourhood Leads as well as Jeremy Tankel, Clinical Lead and Annette Johnson, Safety. Dr Jenny Walton (JW) will attend on behalf of

the LMC. For Salford Royal there would be representation from the 3 divisions, Neurosciences and Mental Health. Dr Peter Turkington, Medical Director would also attend. (FT) also said that the terms of reference allow for the co-opting of representation as and when it was appropriate.

Discussion followed regarding the Neighbourhoods Leads and whether their representation would be from a GP perspective or a commissioning one. Dr Patel (GP) said that he understood that it would be from a GP provider perspective.

Support for the GP workforce

(FT) went on to describe a piece of work that had evolved from the Workforce Development group. She said that 3 work streams had been piloted.

1. Advance Practitioners cohort. This had been run by Salford Health Matters and had resulted in 14 trainees that will be linked with practices.
2. Physician Associates. Salix Health is leading this project in Salford in conjunction with Health Education North West who will contribute to the training and support of these roles. The detail of these roles was still unclear.
3. Practice based Pharmacists. The innovation pilots had evaluated well and a business case has recently been supported to recruit 20 pharmacists to work within practices across Salford. Their main objective was to reduce GP workload and improve medication safety.

(FT) mentioned another programme of work, Making Safety Visible. This work was being done in conjunction with Salford Royal and involved the introduction of a Greater Manchester framework around safety.

4. Council Update

No update available this month.

5. Healthier Together/Primary Care Strategy

Francine Thorpe (FT) advised members that this had not moved on since the last meeting and the challenge raised by UHSM had not yet been resolved.

6. Devomanc

(FT) said that discussions continued but nothing had been agreed so far. The senior leaders from the 12 CCG's and 10 Local Authorities were

working on a transformation plan for the treasury. Governance arrangements still had to be worked through.
