## **AGENDA - PART A**

### **1. Declaration of Interest**

None declared at the start of the meeting.

### **2. Approval of last month's minutes**

Minutes of Mon 10<sup>th</sup> Oct were approved.

### **3. Council Update NHS**

A representative of the council was not in attendance and therefore no update was available however Anthony Hassall (AH) said he would provide some information in his update.

### **4. Salford CCG - Update**

(AH) gave the following update:

He began by talking about GM's plan 'Taking Charge of Health & Social care' produced and published which broadly outlines what GM would like to do. <http://www.gmhsc.org.uk/delivering-the-plan/>  
He said that Cheshire's Sustainability & Transformation Plan (STP) included changes to A&E in some areas.

Engagement with providers continues as work develops to establish an ACO type model.

There is a piece of work underway to look at hospital services across GM. It is well known that many are duplicating delivery of the same services and therefore it was likely that there would be further service changes. (AH) used breast services at Salford Royal as an example and said that changes had been made to enable the service to be delivered in partnership with UHSM Wythenshawe. Elective surgery was mentioned and the possible reduction in surgical sites.

Lots of work was going on to improve back office corporate functions.

Jon Rouse had been appointed as the new Chief Officer for GM Health & Social Care Partnership and was busy building his team.

The LMC asked (AH) for his perspective on changes that would impact on Salford. He said that he believed there would be no change to 24hr A&E, trauma etc. and said that there may be some change in the smaller elective services e.g. ENT. It was likely this would be about site of inpatient

services. He went on to talk about several other possibilities however stressed that no proposals had been put forward at the moment.

(AH) then went on to talk about further significant budget cuts for the council and how the CCG and the LA were working through the various options together. Paul Dennett, City Mayor for Salford, had noted four main priorities as;

Development of social values  
Living wage  
Housing  
High value employment

There was agreement from the LA that there would be fewer cuts in the Adult Social Care budget wherever possible. (AH) reminded everyone that child Services were not part of the integrated care services and work was being reviewed again to look at Sure Start services.

There was mention of the increased pressure on urgent care and discussion followed on the impact to primary care. There was also some discussion around future ideas on how services can be delivered by a primary and secondary integrated care team.

The members event on Tuesday 22<sup>nd</sup> Nov was mentioned and the future employment of 21 Clinical Pharmacists.

At this point in the meeting Dr Tom Tasker (TT) introduced himself and gave members a brief outline of his responsibilities as Chair for Salford CCG and the various engagement activities he was involved in. He mentioned the challenges facing general practice and the work being done to develop Salford Standards further.

## **6. New models of care**

The Executive team had been recruited and confirmed as Dr Paul Bishop, Dr Neil Turton and Dr Mhairi Yates. The next phase of recruitment, which was recruitment of the Neighbourhood Clinical leads, had begun. (MY) went on to talk about the work underway to jointly tender for city wide extended access service with Salford Royal and with Salford Primary Care Together in a lead provider role.
